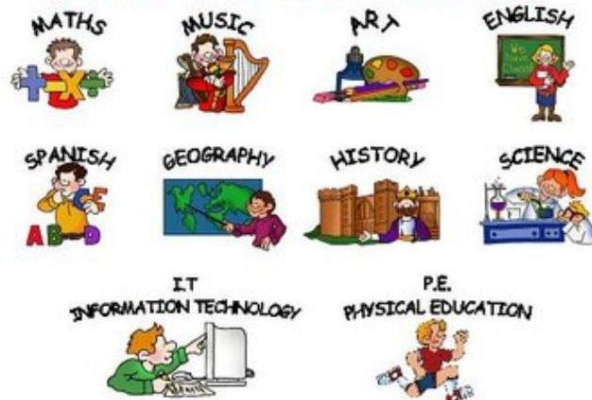

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6. ADVERBS OF MANNER

Forming Adverbs of Manner	
Most adverbs of manner are formed by adding -ly to adjectives .	Example: slowly, loudly, quickly
When an adjective ends with -l , we add -ly .	Example: carefully, beautifully
When an adjective ends with -y , we remove -y and add -ily .	Example: happily, naughtily
For adjectives ending with -ll , we only add -y .	Example: fully
Sometimes, adverbs are formed without making any changes in the adjectives.	Example: fast, hard
